

<b>Gartic Phone</b>	
<b>Theme</b>	Beginner Digital Skills & Team-Building
<b>Target Group</b> <i>(Group Size, Participants Profile)</i>	<p>The game is designed for a group of at least 4 members.</p> <p>Age: over 10 years old</p> <p>Ideally: light mental disability and over.</p> <p>All members should be able to use their hands to paint</p>
<b>Duration</b>	Between 15 minutes to 1 hour
<b>Learning Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- socializing(team-building)</li> <li>- Writing and drawing on smartphone</li> <li>- Making an internet connection</li> <li>- Using an Internet Browser / accessing a Website</li> <li>- Sending and receiving messages (in this case the invite link)</li> </ul>
<b>Preparation</b>	<p>Not much preparation needed. The game needs a quiet room with no interruptions, ideally chairs for everyone to sit comfortably.</p> <p>IF participants don't have internet connection, it will need to be provided by facilitator.</p>
<b>Materials</b>	<p>Each participant needs a smartphone, or else the game cannot be played.</p> <p>Internet connection</p>
<b>Flow / Description</b>	<p>Instructions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Everyone take your smartphone, connect to the internet and open your browser</li> <li>- Go to <a href="https://garticphone.com/">https://garticphone.com/</a>, insert your name and press Start</li> </ul> <p>Facilitator:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Click on Invite, and send the invitation link to all participants.</li> <li>- Wait for everyone to join, and press Start</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The task is simple: write a word, a concept, anything. The second person will have to draw your word / concept. The third person will have to describe the drawing with a word / concept. The next person will draw the second word. And it goes on and on.</li> <li>- Every round has a timer dictated by the computer. At the end of each round you will be able to see every word and every subsequent drawing. Through this you will be able to see how ideas change in time, and how things become misinterpreted.</li> </ul>
<b>Debriefing / Reflection</b>	<p>The main idea of this tool is to understand how ideas are interpreted by different people, how obvious things become easily misinterpreted, and how to communicate clearly with others. What is obvious to you may not be obvious to other people.</p> <p>Make a circle and discuss the activity:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Any problems with using the phone?</li> <li>- Did you notice a pattern of distortion?</li> <li>- Why do you think they didn't understand your drawing?</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- How would you draw the same picture if you had to repeat it?</li><li>- Etc.</li></ul>
